## INDIE THRILLER"LOST" TO OPEN SIMULTANEOUSLY IN LOS ANGELES AND BAGHDAD, IRAQ

Psychological thriller starring Dean Cain to screen for troops

Laemmle Theatres in LA and Pasadena among first theaters to screen "LOST", Opening Friday, May 13, 2005. More theatres to be announced.

Los Angeles, CA - SilverCrest Entertainment today announced the release of "LOST," a twisted cat-and-mouse thriller starring Dean Cain and Danny Trejo, which will open simultaneously on Friday, May 13, 2005 in Los Angeles, CA and Baghdad, Iraq.

The film, which will open at various Los Angeles area theaters including the **Fairfax 3 Laemmle Theater** (7907 Beverly Blvd, LA, CA 90048) and in Pasadena at the **One Colorado Laemmle Theater** (42 Miller Alley, Pasadena, CA 91103), will also screen for the US troops in Iraq as part of a special event spearheaded by Cain and Producer Kevin Matossian.

Cain, who is scheduled to deliver the film in person as part of the "Ambassadors of Hollywood Tour", will hand the print off to Matossian's youngest brother, Cpl Steven V. Matossian. Explained (Kevin) Matossian of the unique screening, "You can't imagine the amount of respect I have for all our service men and women around the world-including my brother who is in Iraq right now. To be able to entertain them, even for a second, is a great honor".

Corporal Matossian said of the screening and Cain's participation, "It makes a world of a difference to us over here-we often forget the great support we have back home. It means even more when that support is expressed by those in the entertainment industry. It says that they are putting all the politics aside to take care of their fellow Americans first. Don't be mistaken, they have an equally important part in the fight for freedom but it has nothing to do with a uniform."

Cain (*Out of Time; The Perfect Husband: The Laci Peterson Story; Lois and Clark*), who will be seen this season in a recurring role on ABC's s hit show *Hope and Faith*, remarked, "We often forget the sacrifices our troops are making for us everyday. I'm excited to be bringing a little reminder of home to these guys; it's the least I can do to say thanks".

"LOST", the feature film debut from Writer/Director Darren Lemke, is the story of one frantic day in the life of Jeremy Stanton (Dean Cain). Driving solo in the desert between California and Nevada, Stanton becomes trapped in an endless maze of secondary roads and washed out highways-losing not only his way, but critical time as well as he and an unseen menace both race to a vital deadline that could cost Stanton his life.
